SUNY FOR ALL

What is SUNY For All

SUNY For All is an initiative of the SUNY Chancellor to create a SUNY Online Training Center to help New Yorkers start their education and improve their job prospects. ATTAIN Labs and EOCs are the entry point to free training.

How does it work

When people across the state make contact through the SUNY For All portal, they are funneled to ATTAIN Labs and EOCs for follow up. At Brooklyn EOC, there are staff members assigned to answer queries and direct inquiries. Depending on the need or desire of the person, they might refer applicants to other programs or direct them to apply to Brooklyn EOC.

What does it mean for BEOC

For the time being, this is another referral source for us; however, in the longer term, SUNY for All may continue as a virtual EOC. However it progresses, the goal of Brooklyn EOC is to provide the appropriate support to enroll, teach, and complete students so that they can continue their career pathway through placement into jobs or college.
