BEOC'S NEW PROGRAM!



Patient Care Technician program

The Patient Care Technician/Assistant Program prepares students to support nurses, physicians, and other medical staff with patient care. A patient care technician (PCT) may perform a variety of basic patient care skills and techniques under the supervision of a nurse or other medical staff. In addition, the PCT is trained to perform electrocardiograms (EKG/ECG) and venipuncture (phlebotomy).

Students enrolled in PCT will gain competency in the following areas:

- Perform basic infection control practices in the Healthcare setting
- Perform phlebotomy procedures
- Use effective skills to draw blood and accurately label tubes
- Perform basic 12-lead ECG/EKG technique and interpretation
- Perform basic patient care skills
- Communicate with a diverse patient population using written and oral communication and listening skills in interactions

Students will be prepared for the following national certifications:

- Certified Patient Care Technician/Assistant (CPCT/A) BEOC expense
- Certified EKG/ECG Technician (CET) student expense
- Certified Phlebotomy Technician (CPT) student expense

The first BEOC PCT class begins in June 2022.

Enrollment

The Enrollment Office staff is committed to providing quality service and a seamless enrollment process for our prospective students. The staff works diligently to provide a positive application experience for all applicants.

The Enrollment Office conducts recruiting activities to increase awareness of BEOC to the community at large. BEOC is now recruiting for summer and fall classes. Recently, the Enrollment Manager Darron Henry and Admissions Coordinator Nicole Cruz visited several sites to participate in information and recruiting sessions.

Ms. Cruz participated in the following events:

- AIM 1 Charter High School: This school sponsored a career and resource fair on April 6. Several organizations participated by providing information on their programs and signing up potential students for upcoming classes. The age range of the students was 15-21 years old. The discussion focused on options for high school students after graduation.
- Brooklyn District Attorney's Office: The Brooklyn DA's office
 facilitates a youth program open to the community. This
 program provides employment and educational resources. Ms.
 Cruz did a short presentation on April 13, discussing BEOC
 program offerings and services.

Mr. Henry participated in the following events:

- South Brooklyn High School: On April 13, Mr. Henry participated in a career seminar for 36 junior and senior high school students. The discussion included speakers providing information on their own careers and why they chose that career path, then they provided information on their programs and its offerings. Mr. Henry provided students with information on BEOC and the benefits of participating in our programs.
- NYCHA: This program sponsored by NYCHA targeted NYCHA residents and provided education and employment resources.
 Mr. Henry presented information about BEOC and the benefits of participating in our programs. Of the 12 participants, five completed an enrollment application.
- Outward Bound: Mr. Henry co-presented at a virtual fair at Outward Bound along with two representatives from the Manhattan EOC, Carmel Urbaez and Yveline Legagneur. This session provided students with information about enrollment and programs at these EOCs.
