Free summer meals for NYC students begin on June 28

New York City students can get a free breakfast or lunch all summer long.

The city's Department of Education <u>Summer Meals Program</u> begins on June 28 and runs through Sept. 2. There is no food service on July 4. Anyone 18 or under can grab a free breakfast or lunch with no identification necessary.

Explore our Direct Support Professional program!

The Direct Support Professional (DSP) program prepares students for entry-level employment as a caregiver. With experience, graduates can qualify for other jobs like Direct Support Specialist, Community Support Worker, or Personal Care Coordinator.

Students are trained to work with mentally ill, and/or developmentally disabled individuals of all ages, to help them attain independence, individuality, and productivity. Students obtain their certificates for program completion, Strategies for Crisis Intervention and Prevention (SCIP), and Approved Medication Administration Personnel (AMAP). Students also receive certification in CPR and First Aid.

Requirements for placement into employment include being able to pass a physical exam and background check; and having no felony convictions.

Movie theaters experiencing popcorn, candy shortages over inflation

Moviegoers flocking back to the cinema this summer after pandemic-induced lockdowns will have to contend with another potential off-screen drama — a shortage of popcorn, candy, soda, and other snacks.

Inflation, a tight labor market, and supply chain disruptions are adversely impacting the availability of food and beverages at movie theaters, according to The Wall Street Journal. Theater operators are also having difficulty restocking key concession stand items such as the bags that hold the popcorn as well as sheen linings that prevent butter from seeping out, the Journal reported. The supply crunch has forced cinemas to limit sales to non-paper containers made of either plastic or metal.

The disruptions to the supply chain have also affected shipments of plastic trays that hold strands of licorice, plastic cups, nacho trays, and soda flavors. Some theater owners have had to buy unused cups from rival theaters that have gone out of business and then use those to serve beverages to customers — even though the logo on the cups is that of a competitor.


