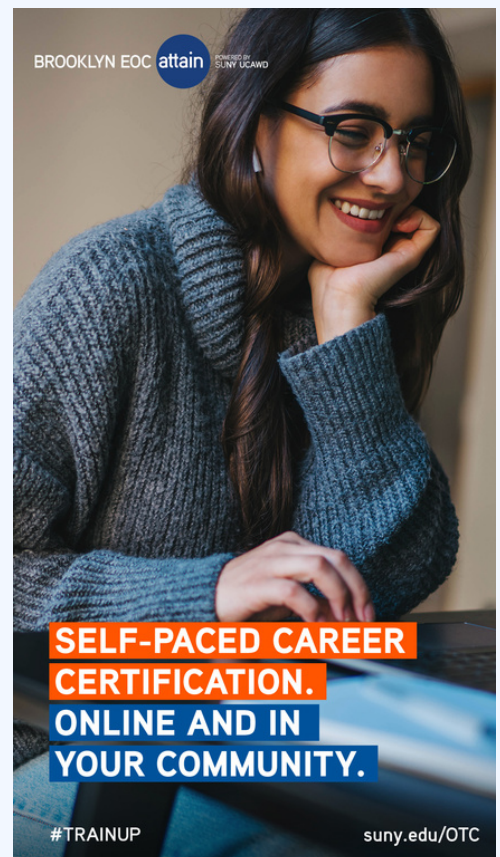
Expand your language skills and enroll in the Rosetta Stone program at the ATTAIN Lab today!
