THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S CORNER

Dear BEOC Community,

April recap - April was a month of energy, connection, and forward momentum at BEOC! On April 25, we were proud to welcome Assembly Member Michael Novakhov (District 45) to our campus, where he visited classrooms, spoke with students, and saw firsthand the life-changing work we do every day. "This is exactly the kind of community partnership we need more of." he said—and we couldn't agree more. We're excited to explore ways to collaborate and serve his district through education, career training, and outreach.

We've also made some incredible additions to our team: please join me in welcoming Mary Sumaya as our new Testing Coordinator and Chantay Reaves as our new Admissions Coordinator. Thanks to all of your hard work, our student retention rate has reached 70%-well above our 60% goal-and we've already completed 30% of our annual target, with more students on track to complete by June. We're currently serving 1,012 students, or 63% of our 1,615 enrollment goal, and I'm proud to say we're pacing ahead of last year. Our College Connections team is supporting 350 students toward college—125 from the broader community and 225 from our current enrollment-and Career Services has helped secure 27 job placements so far.

Additionally, I hosted a fireside chat with students, and their feedback is already shaping our next steps. "It means a lot to be heard", one student shared-and that message rings true across all we do. We also acknowledge that April is National Second Chance Month, also known as Reentry Awareness Month. This national observance highlights the need to support individuals returning to their communities after incarceration and to break down the barriers they face. At BEOC, we believe in second chances—and in the role education plays in creating them. April was also Denim Day, an annual global campaign held on the last Wednesday during Sexual Assault Awareness Month. On this day, people wear denim to challenge harmful stereotypes, raise awareness about sexual violence, and show solidarity with survivors. It's a visible statement against victim-blaming, and a reminder that we stand together for justice, healing, and equity. The finish line is near, and together, we are making it count.

I am now excited to embark on this new college adventure in BMCC, and I hope to, in turn, pass on the values of support and generosity that you manifest so well.


